Please pick up your artwork from the **Black & White** exhibit after 4 pm and before 6:00 pm.

Last day of the exhibit is April 23, 2018. If you are unable to pick up your artwork, please make arrangements with one of the other artists and notify Janet Barnes or Robin Rossi as to whom that other artist will be.

Framed art must be ready to hang with eye hooks and wire attached to the back of the artwork. Please tape wire ends to protect handler's hands. Hanging fiber entries must be less than 48" in width at the top of the piece. Each entry must have loops or sleeves at the top edge; artist must supply the support system or rod for the artwork. Support structures for Wearable Art and Jewelry Art to be provided by the artist.

All art must have identifying labels with the artist's name, medium and price attached to the work. Please attach to the upper left-hand corner on the back of the frame.

All art must be original; no use of copy- written type of material.

All art must be dry.


