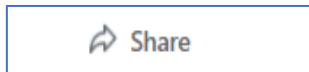

## Gallery Review

**The Rena Charles Gallery**, located at 439 Healdsburg Avenue, in Healdsburg, California is situated in the center of the wine country. This small, elegant gallery features photos, abstracts and landscapes, done by local artists, many of them women and minorities. Most of the works are large and pack the kind of punch one might expect from such overwhelming pieces.

One artist, Clark Mitchell, does very large pastel landscapes – mostly in muted tones. One work, Almond Orchard is a good example of his style. Flowing pale colors and cloud-like shapes define a fine, dreamlike scene worthy of a true impressionist. Another painter, Aaron Webb, does mixed media items, rendered mostly in whites, greys and coppery tones.

One self-taught artist, Lina Chambliss, does very large acrylics of animals and birds rendered in bold, inventive graphic patterns and very bright, hard-edged colors. She arrives at an almost pop art like effect with her oversized compositions, with their dramatic, intense and graphic look. A fine viewing experience, located in old town Healdsburg.

Enjoy the whole thing, the park, the 19th century buildings, the gallery itself.
