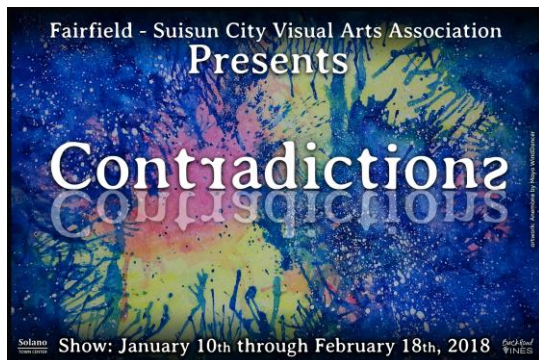

Membership Dues

There have been some substantial changes this year with the FSVAA. Dues have changed. We now offer two galleries to all our members (no other group does that). We're looking into buying the Lawler House building and applying for several grants. There have also been some policy changes about how often you are required to docent. Here are the changes in a nutshell.

1. All members must be up to date with their dues and your docent requirements to participate in shows. Fairfield-Suisun City Visual Arts Association Membership dues now gives you the opportunity to display your work in both the **Solano Town Center Gallery** and the **Lawler House Gallery**. FSVAA Membership dues are now \$50 and due on January 1st of each year.
2. Docent requirements: In order to display your work, you have to have been a docent once a month for the past two months from intake date. You can docent at either gallery even if you are not showing work in that gallery.
