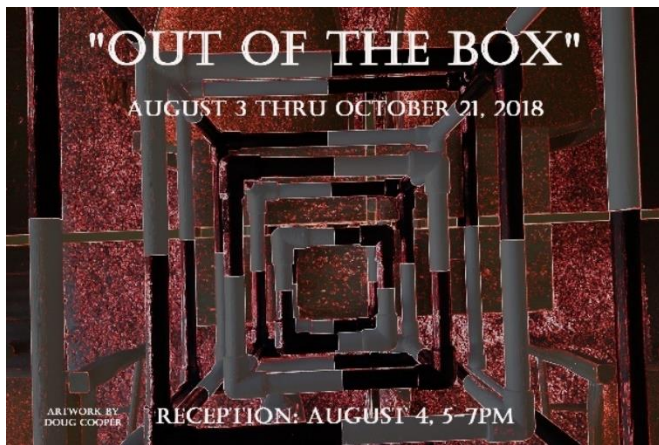

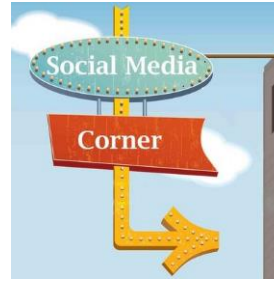

Hashtags # in Social Media

What is a hashtag? Basically, it's a way to join in conversations on Social Media to connect you to others within the same topic and interests that you have.

- *You can follow hashtags (#) to stay connected with other artists, associations and interests you care about*
- *Use hashtags that are relevant to your art or your interests*
- *Hashtags work best if placed in the description of photos posted on Instagram or Facebook – They are more commonly used in Instagram*
- *Be sure to place a space between hashtags (otherwise they are useless); each hashtag needs to be separated*
- *Be sure to use hashtags that are commonly used – do some research; be sure they are in use*
- *Only 30 hashtags are allowed per photo posted*
- *Keep a list of your best hashtags on your phone or your computer, so you'll always have them available when you post a photo*
- *It's a fact "that posts with at least one Instagram hashtag average 12.6% more engagements than posts without a hashtag"*
