The Lawler House Gallery and the Gallery at Solano Town Center have very limited space and need most of that space for storage of exhibit items such as pedestals, tables, and reception items. Unfortunately, this leaves us without any space to safely store art after an exhibit comes down. Regrettably, we must implement a new policy to encourage people to pick up their art when an exhibit is over.

Effective immediately, artwork not picked up by the close of business on the art pickup date, will be subject to a \$5.00 per week storage fee for up to eight weeks (\$40.00 total). If artwork is not picked up after eight weeks, the artwork will be considered abandoned and become the property of the Fairfield-Suisun City Visual Arts Association to dispose of as deemed necessary.

I hope you understand that we **do not** want to deem any work abandoned, but (*some*) members must be more diligent about retrieving their art and I hope this new policy will motivate them to do so.
